## STANDARD The size of the wicket

A famous cricketing standard — the present dimensions of  $28\text{"} \times 9\text{"}$  for the size of the wicket — was set in 1947, having started off in 1700 at  $22\text{"} \times 6\text{"}$  with two stumps and one bail. And to go even further back, the size of the wicket, the distance of the crease from it, and the length of the pitch, all correspond with divisions or multiples of the early Tudor unit of length measurement, the "gad" of  $16\frac{1}{2}$  ft. and the "ell" of 45 inches.
