DR PETER PARISH

Dr Peter Parish, Senior Medical Research Fellow at the Medical Sociology Research Centre, University College, Swansea has been appointed Visiting Professor at the University of Minnesota for 12 months from 1 September 1975. The appointment has been made jointly

by the School of Medicine and College of Pharmacy to enable Dr Parish to carry out research into the teaching of pharmacology, therapeutics, and clinical pharmacy.
