TENORMIN FOR MODERATE HYPERTENSION TENORMIN LS FOR MILD AND OLDER HYPERTENSIVES

'Tenormin' and 'Tenormin' LS Prescribing Notes

PRESENTATION: 'Tenormin' tablets containing atenolol 100 mg are round, bi-convex, orange and film coated. 'Tenormin' LS tablets containing atenolol 50 mg are round, bi-convex, orange and film coated.

USES: Management of Hypertension.

DOSAGE: "Tenormin' 100 mg orally once a day and Tenormin' LS orally once a day; some patients may respond adequately to "Tenormin' low strength.

CONTRAINDICATIONS: Heart Block.

PRECAUTIONS: Untreated cardiac failure, bradycardia, renal failure, anaesthesia, pregnancy. Caution in patients with chronic obstructive airways disease. Tenormin' modifies the tachycardia of hypoglycaemia.

Co-administration of verapamil or Class I antidysrhythmic agents.

Withdrawal of clonidine. Withdrawal of beta-blocking drugs should be gradual in patients with ischaemic heart disease.

SIDE EFFECTS: Coldness of extremities, bradycardia and muscular fatigue may occur. Sleep disturbance rarely seen. Rashes and dry eyes have been reported with beta-blockers—consider discontinuance if they occur. PACK SIZE AND BASIC NHS COST: "Tenormin' 28's \$6.98; "Tenormin' LS 28's \$4.88.
